MATERIALS LIST

- 1 Ciao Bella Woodland paper pack
- 1 EK Tools trim punch (1/4", 1/2", or 5/8")
- 1 Coredinations 110 lb cardstock 8-1/2 x 11
- 1 Roll 3/8" Scor Tape
- 1 Miniature Christmas Tree

Art Glitter Glue and also the metal tip

2 yards White Rhinestone flat back trim

<u>Stickles</u> (I used a variety of colors to decorate with) Xmas red, Silver, Magenta, Sea Spray, Jade, , Ice blue, Golden Rod, Lime Green

Various Miniatures for Decorating inside & outside house

Battery operated Tea lights (to light the inside of your house with)

Optional Idea: Xmas picks (to disassemble and use around your house)

Red Ribbon

Other things you may want: If you have diecut wreaths or a "Merry Christmas" Stamp.

Precutting Measurement & Scoring Guide

** Note: See video tutorial for decorative paper cuts I made if you want an exact replica of my project** We will review all pre-cuts and the scoring together in video for accuracy.

Qty:

Decorative Paper

- 2 8-1/4 x 11" pieces of Decorative Paper (House) Scoring: Lay your paper 11" across your board. Score at 1/2" and 5-1/2"
- 2 4-15/16" x 5-7/16" pieces of Decorative paper (Floors)
- 4-15/16" x 5-3/8" piece of Decorative paper (Inside Floor)
- 1 7 x 11" piece. (Roof) Scoring: Lay your paper 11" Across your board. Score at 5-1/2".
- 5-1/2 x 5-1/2" pieces (Peaks)
 Cut diagonally on each so you will have 4 equal triangles.
 Scoring: lay our paper so the longest side is against your board edge (7-3/4" across).
 Score at 1-1/8" and 6-5/8".
- 2 1-1/8" x 5-1/2" pieces. (Top Floor Supports)
 Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 5-1/2" across. Score at 1/4" and 5-1/4"
- 2 3/8" x 7" pieces (Roof Trim)
- 2 3/8 x 5-1/2" pieces (Roof Trim)

White Cardstock 110 lb:

- 2 6 x 6-1/2" pieces of White Cardstock. (Floors) Scoring: Score each side at 1/2".
- 1 7 x 11" piece. (Roof) Scoring: Lay your paper 11" across your board. Score at 5-1/2".
- 5-1/2 x 5-1/2" piece. (Peak)
 Cut diagonally so you have 2 equal triangle pieces.
 Scoring: lay our paper so the longest side is against your board edge (7-3/4" across).
 Score at 1-1/8" and 6-5/8".
- 2 1-1/8 x 7" pieces (Roof Trim) Scoring: Lay your piece 1-1/8" across. Score at 1/2"

- 4 1-1/2 x 5-1/2" pieces (Roof Trim). Scoring: Lay your paper so you are 1-1/2" across. Score at 1/2".
- 2 1-1/8" x 5-1/2" pieces. (Top Floor Support)
 Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 5-1/2" across. Score at 1/4" and 5-1/4"

<u>Door cutting, scoring, and Placement</u> – See video for instructions.

Windows – See Video for further instructions

If you do not have a window frame die and need to make them by hand, the following is what you'll need:

- 1 2 x 3" piece of White Cardstock. Label this Window Template
- 7 2-1/2 x 3-1/2 pieces of Decorative paper (Window Trim)

Place your 2 x 3" Window template on top of your $2-1/2 \times 3-1/2$ " window trim. Center Your template. Draw around your template. Cut on your lines. This will then give you 7 window frames.

Note: Reserve all scrap pieces from your cuts. You may want to use this – Discussed in Tutorial.

** Do not discard your window template after use. You will need this in the tutorial.
