- 1 <u>Simple Stories Merry & Bright Paper Pack</u> or if you want to make the other lantern you saw in the video <u>Stamperia Grand Hotel</u>
- 1 sheet (12 x 12 size) Clear .007 thickness plastic sheet or 2 8-1/2 x 11 size.
- 1 Flameless candle
- 2 sheets of Medium Weight Chipboard
- 1 each of 3/8 " and 1/4" Scor Tape
- 1 Holiday Pick or more if you want to mix it up
- 4 Balls for feet I used these Doll head knobs 1.5"
- 1 small ball for top you can use 1" doll knob or something else

Art Glitter Glue and the Metal tip

Hot Glue gun for quick tacking

Ribbon – ¼" wide your choice of color

PRECUTTING MEASUREMENT AND SCORING GUIDE

CHIPBOARD CUTS

QTY:

- 1 4-3/4 x 5-1/2" piece. Label: Inner Base Support
- 1 5-3/4 x 6-5/8" piece. Label : Lid
- 2 3-7/8 x 4-1/2" pieces. Label: Lid Stoppers
- 1 6-7/8 x 7-7/8" piece. Label: Base

CLEAR PLASTIC / ACETATE

6 2-11/16" x 6-7/8" pieces.

DECORATIVE PAPER

- **** Please wait for the tutorial before cutting your decorative paper so you know where the following pieces will be shown on your project. This will help you coordinate them and get the look you want.
- 8 x 9-1/4" pieces. Hexagon Frame Scoring: lay your paper 9-1/4" across your scoring board. Score at 1/2", 3-1/4", 6", and 8-3/4" Turn your paper so it's 8" across your board. Score at 1/2" and 7-1/2".
- 2 8 x 8-1/4" pieces. Hexagon Frame Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 8-1/4" across your board. Score at 2-3/4" and 5-1/2". Turn your paper so it's now 8" across your board. Score at 1/2" and 7-1/2".
- 2" x 2" pieces. Topper Scoring: Lay your paper so its 2" across your board. Score at 1/2".
- 1 6-3/4 x 7-5/8" piece Lid Wrap
- 1 5-3/4 x 6-5/8" piece Under Lid cover
- 1 7-7/8 x 8-7/8" piece Base Wrap
- 1 6-7/8 x 7-7/8" piece Bottom of base
- 1 4-3/4 x 5-1/2" piece Inner base support cover
- 1 1-3/4" x 6" piece Top Ring (you can use left over decorative paper scrap piece as I did in tutorial)
- 1 **You can use regular cardstock for this *** 1-3/4 x 6" piece. Label: Window Template
