## Part 3 - Creating the start to finish page 2 -3, including using our design paper to complete the finish look.

## PAGE 2 - Front (cardstock = CS)

Double Flip Pocket - Magnets are required
Cut 1 pc of white CS @ $61 / 4 \times 61 / 4$ inches;
Cut 1 pc of white CS @ $61 / 4 \times 63 / 4$ inches; With the $63 / 4$ inch at the top of the scoreboard
Score $1 / 2$ inch on the left side
Cut 1 pc of white CS @ $6 \times 41 / 2$ inches
Creating our Hinge - You will need a 1 inch piece from your scrap pile; Score this piece at $1 / 2$ inches (down the middle)
This is going to become a hinge for your $6 \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch piece

## PAGE 2 - Back (cardstock = CS)

Double Fold Photo Mat- Magnets required
Cut 1 pc of white CS @ $6 \times 12$ inches; With 12 inches top of scoreboard Score @ 6 inches
Cut 1 pc of white CS @ $6 \times 6$ inches
Creating our Hinge - You will need a 1 inch piece from your scrap pile; Score this piece at $1 / 2$ inches (down the middle)
This is going to become a hinge for your $6 \times 12$ inch piece

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## PAGE 3 - Front (cardstock = cs)

Gatefold with a Flip - Magnets are required
Cut 1 pc of white CS @ $63 / 4 \times 61 / 4$ inches; Score $1 / 2$ inch on the left side of the $63 / 4$ inch along top of scoreboard Cut 2 pcs of white CS @ $35 \times 6 \times 1 / 4$ inches; Score $1 / 2$ inch on the left side of the $35 / 8$ inch along top of scoreboard.
Addition - I also show you how to create a Frame with the $6 \times 6$ cut-a-part Frames using your acetate. ************************************Refer to tutorial how to assemble ****************************************)

## PAGE 3 - Back (cardstock = CS)

## 6x6 Pocket -

Cut 1 pc of white CS @ $71 / 4 \times 65 / 8$ inches; Score $1 / 2$ inch on the left and right side with the $71 / 4$ inch along the top of the scoreboard; TURN - with the $65 / 8$ inch along the top of scoreboard Score $1 / 2$ inch on the left side. Great Tip - We will be using our Spellbinders Die Cut to accent the left side of the page for a tuck area for tags or small photo mats.
