Materials

2 Magnets

Designer Paper (I used left over papers from <u>Stamperia Princess paper collection</u> Solid colored Cardstock (whatever you have) I used <u>80 lb Black</u>

Glue - Art Glitter dries clear

Optional Embellishments:

Tim Holtz Ornate Frames

1 Nail File

Precutting/ Scoring Guide

2 Pieces of designer paper cut to 2-1/4" x 8-1/2".

Note: This is for the Front and Back of your Nail file holder.

1 Piece Designer paper 2-3/4" x 6".

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 2-3/4" across your board. Score at 1/4" and 2-1/2". Now turn your paper so it's 6" across your board. Score at 1/4".

Note: This is your pocket.

1 Piece Designer paper 1-1/4" x 2-1/4".

Note: This covers your magnet on your pocket.

1 Piece of Designer paper 2-1/4" x 9-1/2".

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 9-1/2" across your board. Score at 4-3/4".

Note: This is your flap/closure.

1 Piece of Black or other solid colored cardstock 2-1/4" x 8-1/2".

Note: This is your base.
