MATERIALS & PRECUTTING-SCORING GUIDE



Materials:

2-3/4 sheets out of the [Stamperia Hortensia paper collection](#)
1 sheet of [12 x 12 size Medium Weight Chipboard](#) or buy the [Value Pack](#)
3 sheets of [Coredinations 65# 8-1/2 x 11 cardstock - white](#)
[Tyvek](#)
[Scor Tape 3/8"](#)
[Art Glitter Glue \(dries clear\)](#) and the [Precision Metal Tip](#)
5" x 8" Note pad / Writing Tablet (for inside your Notebook)
6" piece of 1/8" wide ribbon
Pen or pencil for inside your notebook.
Lace (optional) – I used [White Fancy Pearl Scallop lace](#)
[Stickels \(optional\)](#)

Precutting – Scoring Guide

*** Please use Pencil to label your pieces***

Chipboard:

Qty:

2 5-1/2 x 8-1/2" Chipboard . Label: Cover

1 1" x 8-1/2" Chipboard. Label: Spine

Tyvek

2 1-1/4" x 8-1/2" piece

White 65# Cardstock

2 7-5/8 x 10-1/2" cardstock. Label: Notebook Wrap)

1 6-3/8" x 7-7/8" cardstock.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 6-3/8" across your board. Score 1/2", 5/8", 5-3/4", and 5-7/8".

Turn your paper so it's now 7-7/8" across. Score at 1/2" and 5/8".

Label: Lg. Pocket

1 4 x 6-1/2" cardstock.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 4" across. Score at 1/2" and 5/8".

Turn your paper so it's now 6-1/2" across. Score 1/2", 5/8", 5-7/8" & 6".

Label: Sm. Pocket

Decorative Paper Precuts (Do not Write on your paper)

1 8-1/8" x 12" piece. (Inside Cover)

2 5-1/2 x 8-3/8" pieces. (Outside Covers)

1 1" x 8-3/8" piece. (Outside Spine Cover)

1 5 x 7" piece. (Lg Pocket Cover)

1 3-1/4" x 5" piece. (Sm. Pocket Cover)

1 2" x 5" piece. (Notepad Top Cover)
