Materials

1-1/2 Sheets of Decorative Paper – For Each tissue cover, I used <u>Mintay Lady</u> and <u>Ciao Bella</u> Frozen Roses

2 sheets of 12 x 12 Medium Weight Chipboard

1 sheet of Black Cardstock (8-1/2 x 11 size okay)

3/8" Scor Tape

Art Glitter Dries Clear Glue and also the Metal Precision Tip

1 box of Kleenex (Upright style)

PRECUTTING – SCORING GUIDE

** please use pencil and label your pieces**

Chipboard

Qty:

4 5" x 5-1/2" pieces of chipboard. Label: 5 x 5-1/2" Sides

1 5-1/8" x 5-1/8" piece chipboard. Label 5-1/8 x 5-1/8" Top

Black Cardstock

4 1" X 5-1/2" pieces. Label: 1" x 5-1/2" Sides

Scoring: Lay your paper 1" across your board. Score at 1/2"

Label: 1" x 5-1/2" Sides

4 1" x 5" pieces. Label: 1 x 5" Top

Scoring: Lay your paper 1" across your board. Score at 1/2"

Label: 1 x 5" Top

Decorative Paper Precuts

The following are precuts for your decorative paper, however, to avoid cutting it wrong (For example, if you have an image on your paper, wait for the tutorial to see how your pieces will lay first).

Do not label or write on your pieces.

Qty:

- 2 6" x 6"pieces (these will be 2 of your sides).
- 2 5" x 6" pieces (these will be the other 2 sides)
- 1 5-1/8" x 5-1/8" piece. (this will be your top
- 4-7/8" x 4-7/8" piece (this will be hidden under your top inside the box)
