# **Materials List**

2 Stamperia Provence 12 x 12 paper packs

1 pack American Crafts White 80 lb 12 x 12 Cardstock

1 pack Basic Gray Large Magnets

Art Glitter Dries Clear Glue and the Metal Tip

1/4" Scor Tape

3/8" scor tape (optional)

# **Precutting – Scoring Guide**

- \* All measurements & scoring below are on your white cardstock. Decorative paper measurements will be given in the tutorial.
- \*\* If you are unsure of any scoring below, we will review it in the tutorial
- \*\*\* Below are precuts for each section of the folio.
- \*\*\*\* Please write lightly with pencil to label your pieces as instructed below.

#### **FOLIO BASE**

Qtv:

2 8-1/4" x 12" pieces. Label: Folio Base

**Seaming**: Lay your pieces so they are 12" across in front of you. On **ONE** of your sheets, lay a piece of 1/4" scor tape along the short side edge (8-1/4" side) without going over the edge. Take your other piece and lay the short side (8-1/4" side) over the 1/4" scor tape to seam together. This is will create a long sheet approx. 23-3/4" (depending on overlap you did, it can be slightly shorter) wide x 8-1/4" tall.

**Scoring**: Lay our piece on your scoring board so it's 23-3/4" across.

Score at: 2-1/2", 4", 10-1/4", and 11-5/8".

Now rotate your paper around so it's again laying 23-3/4" across – we are now scoring the opposite side. Score at: 5-1/4" and 5-7/8".

Label your piece: Base

NOTE: If you are confused, we will do this together in video.

#### **OUTSIDE PANEL**

Qty:

1 3-7/8" x 5" piece. Label: Outside Panel Pic Mat

### PANEL 1 – P1

Qty:

1 3-1/2" x 6" piece.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 3-1/2" across your scoring board. Score at 1/2".

Now turn your paper so it's 6" across and score at 1/2" and 5-1/2".

Label: Panel 1 – P1 Pocket

#### **PANEL 2 – P2**

Qty:

2 6-1/4" x 8" pieces.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 6-1/4" across your board. Score at 1/2".

Label: P2 6-1/4 x 8 Fold Out

2 5-7/8 x 8" pieces.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 5-7/8" across your board. Score 1/2" and 3/4".

Label: P2 5-7/8 x 8 Fold Out.

2 5-1/2 x 6" piece.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 5-1/2" across your board. Score 1/2" and 1".

Label One: P2 5-1/2 x 6 Top Flip Label Other: P2 5-1/2 x 6 Bottom Flip

2 4 x 6" pieces.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 4" across. Score at 1/2".

Now turn your paper so it's 6" across and score at 1/2" and 5-1/2".

Label: P2 4 x 6 Pocket

#### **PANEL 3 – P3**

Qtv:

2 8 x 12" pieces.

Scoring: Lay your paper 12" across. Score at 1/2", 1", and 6-5/8".

Label: P3 8 x 12 Fold out

2  $4 \times 6-3/8$ " pieces.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 4" across your board. Score at 1/2".

Now turn your paper so it's 6-3/8" across and score at 1/2" and 5-7/8".

Label: P3 4 x 6-3/8 Pocket

5 4-1/2 x 5" pieces.

Scoring: lay 4-1/2" across your board. Score at 1/2".

Label: (You only need to label 1) P3 4-1/2 x 5 Waterfall (keep all together in a stack)

1 5-1/2 x 6" piece.

Scoring: Lay 5-1/2" across your board and score at 1/2" and 3/4".

Label: P3 5-1/2 x 6" Bottom Flip

1 6 x 8-1/2" piece.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 8-1/2" across your board. Score at 1/2" and 3/4".

Label: P3 6 x 8-1/2 Top Flip
