MATERIALS

1 [Mintay Glam Rock 12 x 12 paper pack](#)

1 Sheet of [Medium Weight Chipboard 12 x 12 size - Any color - it gets covered](#)

1 [American Crafts Black 80# 12 x 12 cardstock](#)

[Art Glitter Dries Clear Glue](#) and the [Metal Tip](#)

[Beacon Fabri Tac](#)

1 sheet of [Brown or Black Embossed Vinyl](#)

[Tyvek](#)

[Zots 3D](#)

[Scor Tape 3/8" or 1/4"](#)

[Dritz 4 Coat Hooks & Eyes \(small hook & eye for closure\)](#) Optional: Or use Ribbon for closure

If you have the Spellbinder Swirl Bliss Pocket Die, you can create a fancy die cut pocket like Jessica's original album she made me.

Precutting Guide

NOTES – The following precuts are for your chipboard, Tyvek, and black cardstock only.
We cut the designer Glam Rock paper in the video together.

BASE ALBUM

Chipboard:

Qty:

2 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces. Label: Cover

1 1" x 6-1/2" piece. Label: Spine

Tyvek

2 1" x 6-1/4" pieces (no need to label)

Cardstock

1 8-1/2 x 12" piece. Label: Album Wrap

1 5-1/8" x 6-3/8" piece.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 5-1/8" across your scoring board. Score at 5/8".

Label: Inner Page

***** The rest of the precuts will be made on your black cardstock******

DECORATING THE OUTSIDE

1 3-1/8 x 3-7/8" piece. Label: Mat

PAGE 1

There are no precuts

PAGE 2

1 3-1/2 x 5-1/4" piece.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 3-1/2" across your board. Score at 1/2". Now turn your paper so it's laying 5-1/4" across. Score at 1/2" and 4-3/4".

Label: Pg 2 Pocket

PAGE 3

1 3-1/4 x 7-1/8" piece.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 3-1/4" across. Score at 1/2". Turn your paper so it's now laying 7-1/8" across. Score at 1/2" and 6-5/8".

Label: Pg 3 Side Pocket

PAGE 4

1 4-3/4 x 6-1/8" piece.

Scoring: lay your paper so it's 4-3/4" across. Score at 1/2".

Label: Pg 4 Fold Out.

The Pocket - Optional Pocket

If you are NOT diecutting a special pocket, cut the following:

2 2-3/4 x 5-1/4" pieces.

Scoring: Lay your paper so it's 2-3/4" across your board. Score at 1/2". Now turn your paper so it's 5-1/4" across and score at 1/2" and 4-3/4".

Label: Pg 4 Top Bottom Pocket

If you are diecutting a pocket with dies, you will die cut 2 pieces. Do not assemble just in case you need to adjust the pocket score lines that may have been produced when you die cut your pieces.
